Multi/Interdisciplinary Sources

Summon

Search across the wide spectrum of library owned and leased content - books, articles, images, etc.

WorldCat

A database of materials held by libraries around the world.

- nearly 180 million records
- 470+ languages from 112 countries and territories
- borrow items via Interlibrary Loan

ProQuest Dissertations and Theses

References, summaries of doctoral dissertations and masters theses from more than 700 academic institutions

- full text provided for selected titles only -- try Interlibrary Loan!

Web of Science

A multidisciplinary database with special features:

- references to conference proceedings
- cited reference searching
- related records searching

Academic Search Complete

Scholarly and popular articles in all subject areas.

Google Scholar - <http://scholar.google.com>

Books, articles from scholarly publishers, and materials in college and university repositories. Also includes information about the number of times a work has been cited (better for books than articles).
