Top Anthropology Databases

- Anthropology Plus
 - largest anthropology-specific database, international in scope, includes publications back to the late 19th century
- Abstracts in Anthropology
 - provides brief summaries of articles
- AnthroSource
 - only publications by the American Anthropological Association (not all are scholarly/peer reviewed)
- eHRAF World Cultures
 - full text ethnographies, tagged with culture codes at the paragraph level
